Students entering Spanish 3 HONORS:

The foreign language department expects the students to complete a few activities this summer. Once the students return from summer break, they will receive a test grade for all the work done during the summer, covering the items listed on this page during the first week of school.

1. • Descubre 3 Chapter 1 Pages 16 & 17 Virtual book (vhl central)

Practice your vocabulary, and learn it well. Vocab Quiz first week of class. **ALL vocabulary!**

2. • Summer reading. Each student should purchase their own book. It is available at Amazon and the prices are between \$14.95 - \$30.99. The options are **Mi propio Auto** by Blaine Ray Workshops, **Pobre Ana** by Blaine Ray, **Casi se muere** by Lisa Ray Turner and Blaine Ray workshops and **La maldición de la cabeza reducida** by Vineland's Regional High School. When the students return to school, they will do an in-class project, a book report, and an in-class essay.

3. • In addition to the above, students should complete a minimum of 40 minutes per week of Spanish work during June and July, focusing primarily on reading and listening activities, vocabulary building, and grammar review. I recommend doing four different activities per week. Record it in a journal.
